All digging requires the 48-hour notification so that buried telephone line, television cable, pipelines, utility electrical lines, municipal water and sewer lines can be located to ensure that none will be severed or damaged.

Local democracy and disaster relief priorities signed into law

Last month Governor Dayton signed into law the budget and omnibus bills, including the Jobs and Energy Bill and the Public Safety Bill that contained two of our legislative priorities as they relate to your cooperative.

The Public Safety Bill included a provision that grants electric cooperatives access to the state disaster relief fund that previously was inaccessible to us. This provision



will provide much-needed financial help when dealing with devastating natural disasters like we experienced in July 2016.

Damage to electric cooperative lines is included in the calculation that triggers Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Disaster Declarations and co-ops are currently eligible for federal assistance. This change provides access to state funds. We applaud our legislators for their support on the issue and the governor for signing this into law.

Our Local Democracy provision was included in the Jobs and Energy Bill and solidifies our ability to self-regulate as a member-owned cooperative – and rightly so. Under the provision, electric cooperative boards will have autonomy to work with their member-owners as it relates to distributed generation systems connected to your distribution system. The provision also eliminates duplicative regulation by the Public

Utilities Commission. This seems like common sense to me, and I find it somewhat ironic that we needed legislative action to have the authority to work with our own member-owners on distributed generation issues. The law requires electric cooperative boards of directors to formally assume this authority from the PUC, if that is their desire. Your board of directors has discussed this issue at length and intends to assume this authority at its July board meeting.

Systemwide meter upgrade – installing new meters to help serve you better



Work continues on our systemwide meter upgrade and to date we have installed almost 10,000 new meters. Our existing metering system was installed in the mid-1990s and has reached its end-of-life, and the manufacturer is no

longer supporting this older equipment.

BEC has contracted with a third party metering company, Allegiant Utility Services, which began work in April, to assist in completing the remaining meter exchanges. Allegiant Utility Services' vehicles have its logo, as well as signage designating that they are a contractor for Beltrami Electric. The  contractors from Allegiant Utility Services also wear an ID badge with their name and photo.

The new meters will improve reliability and give you more tools and opportunities to manage and save energy. The impact of the installation is minimal. Co-op members can expect to lose power for a few minutes on the day of installation. You may need to reset your electronic devices, such as digital clocks. In addition, the next bill will show two meter readings: one from the old meter and one from the new meter. We will not need to access your home or business, nor will you need to be on-site when this work is performed.

Subscribe to locally produced, renewable solar energy today!



Beltrami Electric Cooperative is building an 80-kW community solar array at our headquarters. Due to a delay in the delivery of the equipment, construction of the array has been pushed back to the end of July, with it completed in August.

The array will consist of 180 photovoltaic panels, with a projected annual average of 450 kWh per panel or average production credit of 37.5 kWh/month. The array will produce more during the sunny days of summer and less during the short days of our Minnesota winters. To provide a point of reference, a residential electric bill averages around 1,253 kWh/month. Members will see the actual kWh production of their portion of the array credited on their electric bill at current electric rates, so if/when electric rates increase, the value of your credit will too.

Community solar gardens like Northern Solar provide interested members an option to purchase renewable, locally produced, solar energy without the hassle of installing, permitting, maintaining and insuring their own solar array. Members may subscribe to as many panels as they wish, up to the equivalent of their annual average usage. Members who wish to participate but may not want to commit to a subscription, may choose to simply purchase a set amount of kWh/month from Northern Solar, up to their average usage, for an additional charge on their electric bill.

As of May 30, we have 102 panels subscribed. If you have been thinking about subscribing but haven't done so yet, the time is now! We have several payment options, including options for members interested in subscribing to a panel(s) and members who simply want to purchase locally produced solar energy on a Pay-As-You-Go basis with no contract. Keep Food Safe

Before, During and After a Power Outage

Unfortunately, power outages do occur from time to time. It's important to know how to keep your food safe during an outage. Use these tips from USDA to help minimize food loss and reduce your risk of illness.

Before power outage	During power outage	After power outage
<p>Keep refrigerator at 40° or below. Freeze items like fresh meat and poultry that you won't use immediately. Keep freezer set to 0° or below. Group frozen foods to help items stay colder longer.</p> <p>If you anticipate an extended power outage, buy dry or block ice to keep the fridge and/or freezer cold.</p>	<p>Keep the refrigerator and freezer doors closed!</p> <p>If the doors stay closed during the length of the outage:</p> <p>A full freezer will hold its temperature for 48 hours.</p> <p>A refrigerator will keep food safe for four hours.</p>	<p>Check the temperature inside your refrigerator and/or freezer.</p> <p>If the temperatures are safe, the food should be safe to eat.</p>

Foods that should be thrown out after an extended power outage:

Meat, poultry or seafood products
Milk, yogurt and other dairy products
Cooked or sliced produce
Eggs and egg products
Soft and shredded cheese
Opened baby formula
Dough and cooked pasta
